CITY OF NASHUA

In the Year Two Thousand and Twenty-Five

RESOLVED by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Nashua that the City of Nashua and the Nashua Police Department are authorized to accept \$650,000 from the State of New Hampshire Department of Safety into Police Grant Activity “FY2026 Substance Abuse Reduction Initiative (SARI) Grant” for the purpose of investigating and apprehending individuals or organizations that are involved in substance related drug use and trafficking. This funding is contingent upon approval by the Governor and Executive Council and shall be in effect through June 30, 2027. No local match is required.

The Mayor is authorized to enter into any grant agreement or other documents necessary to further the purposes hereof.

ANALYSIS

This resolution authorizes the City to accept funds from the State of New Hampshire Department of Safety for the purpose of investigating and apprehending individuals or organizations that are involved in substance related drug use and trafficking. These funds will be used in conjunction with the Town of Hudson Police Department in a joint effort. A related Memorandum of Agreement establishes Nashua as the "Grantee" and Hudson as the "Municipality" where reimbursements to the "Municipality" will be paid by the "Grantee." The grant period is from July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2027.

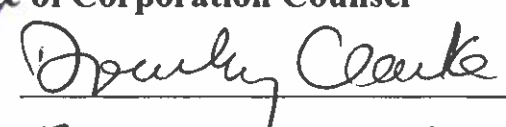

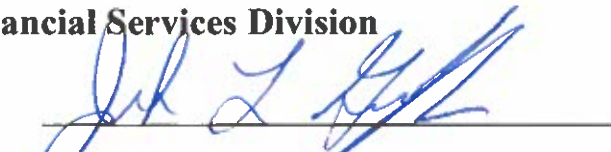
ANALYSIS

This resolution authorizes the City to accept capital and operating match funds from the State of New Hampshire Department of Transportation for State Fiscal Year 2026-2027. The purpose of the funds to match the capital grants from the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") is for Nashua Transit Center upgrades, bus stop infrastructure upgrades (including shelters) and medium duty ADA Paratransit buses. The purpose of the operating match funds is to provide a portion of the non-federal funds required to match Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") operating funds for transit operations.
