Prevention



- ❑ Deny food, water, and harborage
 - / Food waste
 - / Animal feed/waste
 - / Leaky pipes
 - / Clutter & debris
- ❑ Seal any holes/cracks/cervices
- ❑ Maintain a neat and orderly property
- ❑ Clean up rodent sign and monitor for new activity
- ❑ Work with a licensed pest professional to exterminate and exclude
